



## Update for Government of Yukon Retirees

Changes to your Extended Health Care Benefits Plan, effective April 1, 2018

New premium rates for the Extended Health Care insurance plan will be in effect as of April 1, 2018. Our monthly premium rates will be adjusted to reflect changes in the member group's demographics, use of the benefit plan, cost of medical/dental supplies and services as well as the insurer's expenses.

Rates for Extended Health Care will increase 16.1%.

The changes below are effective April 1, 2018 and affect both the employer and retiree contributions.

The premium rates will be reflected in your April 2018 Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) from your bank account.

- The employer/retiree share of the premium is based on years of service prior to retirement.
